

Rovinj

Join us aboard the 36-passenger Queen Eleganza as we sail through some truly beautiful scenery from the picturesque Istrian town of Rovinj to the atmospheric city of Split. Along the way we will call into scenic islands and towns which do not cater for the big ships and each night we remain moored in the attractive harbours. Most vessels sail from the ports at the end of the day, thereby missing the floodlit splendour and lively café society which is so atmospheric in the evening. Remaining moored overnight also allows the opportunity to dine ashore on certain evenings.



Amongst the many highlights of our itinerary are the beautiful old towns of Rab and Hvar, the majestic waterfalls of Krka and the historic wonders of Zadar and Split with their history which dates back to Roman times. In addition to our daily guided tours, there will be ample time to explore at leisure and to relax on board and admire the stunning scenery whilst we cruise along the scenic Croatian coast.

Whether it be the towering cliffs and rich vegetation, scenic waterways and indentations, idyllic islands or the wealth of historic buildings, Croatia has so much to offer the genuine traveller and our itinerary will be appreciated by those who enjoy an eclectic mix of places and an informal style of cruising accompanied by a small group of like-minded travellers.

The Itinerary

Day 1 London Gatwick to Rovinj, Croatia. Fly by scheduled flight to Pula. On arrival transfer to the Queen Eleganza moored in Rovinj. Enjoy the welcome dinner on board this evening as we moor overnight. (D)

Day 2 Rovinj & Mali Losinj. Spend the morning in the atmospheric town of Rovinj where the houses inside the old town are small and lean to each other creating a unique atmosphere. Our guided walking tour will include a visit to the town's main landmark, St Euphemia

Church, which is built on the top of a small hill. This Baroque building built in Venetian style was dedicated to the saint and martyr whose sarcophagus, according to a legend, was miraculously washed ashore somewhere around 800 AD. In the late morning we sail to Mali Losinj which sits at the foot of a protected harbour on the southeast coast of Losinj Island. It is the island's mild climate and rich flora that give Mali Losinj its reputation as one of the most fragrant islands in Croatia; its air is scented with lavender, sage and rosemary. Dine ashore this evening in one of the harbour-side restaurants. (B, L)

Day 3 Mali Losinj & Rab. This morning is free to explore the seafront of old town Mali Losinj which is lined with a string of imposing 19th century houses and villas and is a pleasant place to wander. Over lunch we sail to Rab and join a guided walk through the picturesque Old Town, a perfectly preserved late Medieval Adriatic settlement squeezed into a slender peninsula along which are dotted a sequence of Romanesque campaniles. We will remain moored overnight in the harbour and have the opportunity this evening to dine ashore and sample one of the many local restaurants. (B, L)

Day 4 Rab & Zadar. Sail this morning to Zadar. Once a dominant city on the Adriatic Coast rivalling Venice, Zadar is today a treasured city which has preserved its historical core. Enjoy an afternoon walking

tour strolling around the old town with its Roman columns and portals, Romanesque churches and Renaissance and Baroque palaces. Of particular interest are the 9th century circular Church of St Donat, and the 13th century Romanesque cathedral. This evening you can dine ashore in one of the many restaurants in Zadar as we moor overnight. (B, L)

Day 5 Sibenik & Krka National Park. After a morning cruising we arrive in Sibenik where we visit the majestic waterfalls of Krka. We will take a guided walk along the wooden walkways and across bridges through this unique fjord like landscape with its multiple waterfalls and interesting flora and fauna. Return to Sibenik and enjoy an early evening walking tour through the historic town seeing the Cathedral of St James, the old city walls, and the theatre before we dine on board this evening. (B, L, D)

Day 6 Hvar. Spend a relaxing morning at sea sailing to Stari Grad from where we take a short coach ride across the island to the attractive Old Town of Hvar for a guided walk. We will begin in the main square which is the largest piazza in Dalmatia, see the cathedral, the Franciscan Monastery and the Benedictine Nunnery where we hear about the aloe lace still produced today by the nuns. Return to the ship and enjoy dinner on board. We will moor overnight in Stari Grad allowing time for an after dinner stroll in this tranquil locale. (B, L, D)

Day 7 Brac. Sail this morning for Brac and the attractive port of Pucisca located at the end of a long bay. Brac is world renowned for the quality of its stone which was used for the Diocletian's Palace in Split as well as the White House in Washington and other parliament buildings in Europe. Spend the afternoon in the charming small town, voted one of the prettiest in Europe, where the building's white roofs create an ambient atmosphere. This evening is free to dine ashore. (B, L)

Day 8 Split. We have the day to enjoy the city of Split. After breakfast we will take a guided walk through the town including the Palace of Diocletian which was built by the emperor in 295-305 AD as his retirement villa. Much of this large building is well preserved and the palace contains Split's Old Town within its walls, making it the only Roman palace that has been continuously inhabited since Roman times. It is a wonderful spot to wander the maze of streets. Return to the ship for lunch and enjoy an afternoon at leisure to explore further at your own pace. Tonight we have our farewell dinner on board as we moor overnight. (B, L, D)

Day 9 Split to London Gatwick. Disembark after breakfast and transfer to the airport for our scheduled flight to London. (B)

Built by Croatian hands, this modern and stylish vessel is one of the finest Croatian flagged vessels of its kind and, with a maximum of just 36 guests, there is the added benefit of a relaxed and informal atmosphere on board. The team of friendly Croatian crew members all speak English and their excellent service and hospitality will do much to add to your enjoyment. Meals served on board have a home cooked feel and feature wholesome, fresh and tasty Mediterranean cuisine and, when dining ashore independently, your knowledgeable Cruise Director will recommend popular local restaurants. This is the perfect ship to escape the formalities of larger vessels and enjoy the casual nature of small ship cruising along the most beautiful of coastlines.

Your Cabin/Suite

The 18 cabins are attractively designed with neutral décor and stylish furnishings. There are six different grades of cabin arranged over two decks; all cabins feature either portholes (all lower deck cabins), small windows (categories 3 & 5) or picture windows (categories 2 & 4) and are spacious with a well-designed layout, comfortable seating and all the mod cons. The cabins vary in shape and size, from 12m² to 22.5m², adding to the vessel's overall charm. Facilities include air conditioning/heating, a spacious shower, large sink with under sink drawer space, a wardrobe, drawers and spacious under bed storage, flat screen television, radio, hairdryer and safety deposit box. Each cabin also has an en-suite bathroom with a shower and toiletries with a small window.

The vessel has been designed with spacious outside public areas including a large Sun Deck with an excellent shaded area. Whether you choose to spend your time indoors in the lounge or bar area, or on a comfortable lounge on the Sun Deck, the ship has many perfect spots from which to relax and watch the passing scenery.

Your Dining




Sun Deck

QUEEN ELEGANZA DECK PLAN


SUN DECK




UPPER DECK
