

ISLAND HOPPING IN CROATIA

Discover the hidden wonders of Croatia
aboard the Queen Eleganza

13th to 20th June 2022



NOBLE CALEDONIA



For those who enjoy cruising amongst beautiful coastal scenery, swimming in clear blue waters and exploring charming fishing ports and ancient towns with a small group of like-minded travellers, this seven night journey exploring the islands of Croatia will surely appeal. From the hidden islands of Northern Dalmatia to Dubrovnik, this unique cruise steers clear of the well-trodden tourist trail. Instead, we will head to some of the quieter spots and out-of-the-way beaches and islands which the Croats themselves escape to; places where you can wander the streets away from crowds and where nightlife means a nightcap by the harbour.

As we make our way along the coast we will experience the untouched nature of the Brijuni Islands and visit Pula with its Roman amphitheatre and Losinj, a classic Adriatic island that is still relatively unspoilt. We will discover secret idylls and uncrowded spots such as the sandy beaches of Susak and the island of Dugi Otok, surrounded by hills, vines and ancient olive groves. As our journey continues south we will visit the delightful islands of Vis and Korcula before reaching Dubrovnik where we have an afternoon to explore this magnificent city.

In addition to our included guided excursions, we have allowed ample time at leisure and, taking advantage of the warm summer temperatures, there will also be opportunities to swim from the ship. With just 36 guests on board, the Queen Eleganza has the advantage of being able to dock centrally in towns and call into secluded bays and hidden coves enabling us to explore parts of the coast that most cruise ship passengers in the region rarely get to visit.





The Itinerary

Day 1 London to Rovinj, Croatia. Fly by scheduled flight. On arrival transfer to the Queen Eleganza. Enjoy our welcome dinner on board this evening as we moor overnight. (D)

Day 2 Brijuni Islands & Pula. Arrive this morning in the 14 islands of Brijuni, which comprise one of Croatia's National Parks and were once the summer retreat of former Yugoslav leader, Tito. Between 1947 and 1980 he spent up to six months a year in the islands. We will explore Veliki Brijun including the 1st century Roman Villa, the nine hectare safari park created by Tito to house the exotic animals gifted to him by world leaders and the Church of St Germain. Later we continue to the tip of the Istrian Peninsula and the former Roman settlement of Polensium, now known as Pula. Here we will discover one of the best preserved Roman amphitheatres left in the world. The Arena, built in the 1st century AD was designed to host gladiatorial contests with seating for up to 20,000 spectators. (B, L, D)

Day 3 Susak & Mali Losinj. Spend the morning cruising and hopefully stop at the island of Susak where we can enjoy a swim at one of the picturesque beaches. In the early afternoon we sail into Mali Losinj which sits at the foot of a protected harbour on the southeast coast of Losinj Island. It is the island's mild climate and rich flora that give Mali Losinj its reputation as one of the most fragrant islands in Croatia; its air is scented with lavender, sage and rosemary. The seafront of the old town is lined with a string of imposing 19th century houses and villas and is a pleasant place to wander. Dine ashore this evening in one of the harbourside restaurants. (B, L)

Day 4 Dugi Otok. We continue our journey, cruising through the Kornati islands before we arrive at Sali, a traditional fishing village on the island of Dugi Otok surrounded by hills and ancient olive groves. On a walking tour of the town we will see the Church of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary with a stunning wooden altar from the 17th century. We also hope to visit the nearby Telascica Nature Park, a beautiful area of islands, islets, rugged cliffs and coves which are home to many endemic plants. We will moor overnight allowing for the opportunity to dine ashore in one of the local restaurants. (B, L)

Day 5 Vis. This morning we sail to the island of Vis which spent much of its recent history serving as a Yugoslav military base, cut off from foreign visitors from the 1950s right up until 1989. This isolation preserved it from development, and today it offers an authentic tranquillity and unique beauty which we will see on an island drive. (B, L, D)

Day 6 Korcula. We will sail this morning, hopefully finding a suitable spot to swim from the ship. In the afternoon we arrive in Korcula, the reputed birthplace of the explorer Marco Polo, where we enjoy some time to walk along the crooked Medieval streets to the elegant squares which are flanked with palaces of the old nobility. We will moor overnight in Korcula and you will be able to dine ashore in the Old Town this evening. (B, L)

Day 7 Dubrovnik. After a morning cruising we arrive in Dubrovnik, the "Pearl of the Adriatic". After a short drive to Pile Gate, we will begin our guided walk through the unique Medieval Old Town of Dubrovnik, which was added to the UNESCO World Heritage List in 1979. See the major attractions such as the Rector's Palace, the Romanesque-Gothic Dominican and Franciscan Monasteries and the Sponza Palace. Return to the vessel for our farewell dinner as we moor overnight. (B, L, D)

Day 8 Dubrovnik to London. Disembark this morning and transfer to the airport for our scheduled flight to London. (B)

Built by Croatian hands, this modern and stylish vessel is one of the finest Croatian flagged vessels of its kind and, with a maximum of just 36 guests, there is the added benefit of a relaxed and informal atmosphere on board. The team of friendly Croatian crew members all speak English and their excellent service and hospitality will do much to add to your enjoyment. Meals served on board have a home cooked feel and feature wholesome, fresh and tasty Mediterranean cuisine and, when dining ashore independently, your knowledgeable Cruise Director will recommend popular local restaurants. This is the perfect ship to escape the formalities of larger vessels and enjoy the casual nature of small ship cruising along the most beautiful of coastlines.

Your Cabin/Suite

The 18 cabins are attractively designed with neutral décor and stylish furnishings. There are six different grades of cabin arranged over two decks; all cabins feature either portholes (all lower deck cabins), small windows (categories 3 & 5) or picture windows (categories 2 & 4) and are spacious with a well-designed layout, comfortable seating and all the mod cons. The cabins vary in shape and size, from 12m² to 22.5m², adding to the vessel's overall charm. Facilities include air conditioning/heating, large sink with under sink drawer space, wardrobe, drawers and spacious under bed storage, flat screen television, radio, hairdryer and safety deposit box. Each cabin also has an en-suite bathroom with a shower and toiletries.

Your Space

The vessel has been designed with spacious outside public areas including a large Sun Deck with an excellent shaded area. Whether you choose to spend your time indoors in the lounge or bar area, or on a comfortable lounge on the Sun Deck, the ship has many perfect spots from which to relax and watch the passing scenery.

Your Dining




Sun Deck

QUEEN ELEGANZA DECK PLAN


SUN DECK




UPPER DECK
